The Amateur Athletic Union of the United States, Inc, Code book, National Policy VII, section B and C requires that notification of election be sent to member clubs **60 days** prior to the local District meeting.

Additionally, Article II Section E.1.4.d requires notification of the District Bi-Annual Legislative Board of Managers and Bi-Annual Sport Committee meetings be sent to member clubs **30 days** prior those meetings. Due to a computer error, the National Office, which is responsible for distributing emails, according to AAU policy, distributed the email about the meeting notice date but not the election notice.

As a result of that notification not going out, the National Officers of the AAU, invoked Article I, Section E.7, and after consultation with the Governor Bray, rescheduled the District Bi-Annual Legislative Board of Managers meeting and Sport Committee meetings for **Sunday July 25, 2010**.

Sports Committee meetings will begin at 11:30 am and the Board of Managers meeting will begin at 1:00 p.m. (Central Daylight Time) Meetings will be held at Henry Metzger Middle School, 7475 Binz Engleman Road, San Antonio, TX 78244.

As a result of the computer error and the information referenced in Item 2 not being delivered by email to our member clubs, the Officers felt that rescheduling the meeting was in the best interest of the member clubs to fully participate in the election process and to allow the national policy that was developed and approved by AAU Congress to be followed.

Anyone wishing to run for an Officer position, those being Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary, Treasurer, and Registrar, or Sport Committee Director of any sport is encouraged and welcome to do so. The procedure for running for office or Sport Director is directed by the policies approved by Congress. These policies are included herein for your convenience. Refer to Item A for District Officers and Item B for District Sport Director. Please click below to familiarize yourself if you desire to run. Once you have reviewed the process, the actual nomination forms are provided below. If you are running for District Officer please click on Items C.
